Need to see a GP in the evening or on the weekend?

Routine and urgent evening and weekend appointments with a GP or nurse are available for all Enfield patients at one of four GP hubs.

Appointments are available:

- Monday to Friday: 6.30pm - 8pm
- Weekends and public holidays: 8am - 8pm

To request an appointment speak to the practice reception staff or call 111 in the evenings or weekends when the practice is closed.

Walk-in access is also available on weekends and bank holidays at some of our GP hubs. Check below for details:

- **Edmonton Walk-In Centre**, Evergreen Primary Care Centre, 1 Smythe Close, Edmonton N9 0TW. Open weekends and bank holidays only from 8am to 8pm.
- **North Middlesex Urgent Care Centre**, North Middlesex Hospital, Sterling Way, Edmonton, N18 1QX. Situated in A&E and open 24 hours a day, every day.
